She co-founded and was executive director of Centro San Juan Diego, a pastoral institute and adult education center for Hispanics in Denver.

ARCHBISHOP GUSTAVO GARCÍA-SILLER, M.SP.S.



Was born in San Luis Potosí S.L.P., Mexico. In 1975 he professed as a member of the Missionaries of the Holy Spirit and was ordained a priest on June 22, 1984 in Guadalajara, Mexico. He served in California and Oregon primarily in formation work and in leadership positions for religious community. He had been elected Provincial just before becoming auxiliary bishop of the Archdiocese of Chicago. He served under Cardinal Francis George from 2003-2010 and then was named the sixth Archbishop of San Antonio. Archbishop Gustavo served as Episcopal Moderator for NCADDHM and recently participated as a Synod Father on the Synod on the New Evangelization.

Is an Assistant Professor of Theology and Latino/a Ministry within Boston College's School of Theology and Ministry.
