The V Encuentro Ministry Series provides national professional development opportunities in English and Spanish that inspire, connect, and offer opportunities to hear best practices, as well as present new initiatives and pastoral responses that emerged from the V Encuentro process.

## WHO IS IT FOR?

- Leaders in parishes, dioceses, and other Catholic organizations and institutions
  who would like to improve their service to the Hispanic/Latino community.
- Leaders from other ministries and ethnic groups interested in a particular ministerial area.

## WHAT IS THE COST?

 The cost per connection is \$28 and includes 28 sets of videos and workbooks, in English and Spanish. Connections are sold as diocesan membership packages, organizational and individual memberships.

## What is a connection?

A connection allows one user to connect to the Ministry Series content with one email address. The content can be shared to train others in person using a projector or by sharing your screen during a virtual event. One connection allows you to train hundreds of pastoral leaders. A Diocesan membership provides various departments and parishes with their own connections. Only one user can be connected at a time per connection. PDF workbooks are available to print and share



## What is included in the membership?

Each connection allows you access to videos and workbooks for each of the 28 ministerial areas in English and Spanish (total of 56). Each Ministerial Area includes four video segments and a workbook.

  - o Prayer and opening remarks from a Bishop (5 min)
  - Video summary of Proceedings & Conclusions with infographics for each ministerial area (3-5 min)
- · Judge (40 min)
  - o Ted Talk-style presentation by an expert in each of the Ministerial Areas includes current reality post V Encuentro, insights, new ecclesial documents, etc. (20 min)
  - o Local conversation among participants or in chat (20 min)
- · Act (30 min)
  - o Panel discussion (3 people) Best practices, new initiatives, and resources that inform ministerial areas (15 min)
  - o Local responses (Instructions/questions 5 min, followed by 10-15 min discussion of actions to take)
- · Closing (5 min)



#### **Workbook as PDF Download**

The workbook will include questions and activities for participants to work on individually, in a group setting, and actions to take.





### **Live Chat/Community**

2-3 Ministerial Areas will be published a month starting in 2022. The full pre-recorded 60 minute videos will be launched live on the membership site with a live chat for participants to comment and ask questions. After live events they can view recordings on demand.
